



# **Quick Guide 1: Welcome to the West Sussex Wastebuster Programme**

This guide is suitable for Headteachers, Senior Leadership Team, Governors, Sustainability Leads, PTA members and anyone school staff with an interest in the environment, in all state funded primary and secondary schools in West Sussex.

## **Purpose**

This guide introduces the Wastebuster programme's goals, benefits, and structure, while also highlighting its alignment with the Department for Education (DfE) Climate Strategy, Ofsted's broader inspection criteria on leadership, personal development, and curriculum enrichment, and resource efficiency initiatives.

## What is the Wastebuster Programme?

West Sussex Wastebusters is provided free of charge to West Sussex schools by the West Sussex Waste Partnership. The programme is designed to support schools in engaging whole school communities in environmental action, providing guidance and tools to reduce environmental impact, unlocking savings through efficiency measures, and measuring the difference this makes. The programme is structured to help schools develop and deliver a climate action plan, offering a framework and an annual cycle of activities throughout the school year. It includes teacher training, assemblies, and student sessions, along with an account to plan and track progress. The programme also provides ready-made, high-quality resources to support delivery, with rewards and recognition to celebrate achievements.
