



Quick Guide 4: Driving Environmental and Financial Savings with Wastebuster

This guide is suitable for Sustainability Leads, Headteachers, Premises Managers, Finance Officers and other SLT staff in all state funded primary and secondary schools in West Sussex.

Purpose

This guide offers practical advice how the Wastebuster programme can help schools achieve significant cost savings and provide access to free resources and rewards, by using the Wastebuster campaigns and linked services to recycle more, reduce waste production and energy and water consumption.

As well as helping schools make direct saving on their waste and energy services, the programme provides opportunities to access additional resources (e.g. free books/ book vouchers, education materials and more) by participating in school collection services for recyclables brought into school or for promoting community services link to schools' campaigns.

The programme also supports schools to deliver obligations under the new DfE sustainability strategy. Helping schools plan, deliver and assess impact on support of their school's Climate Action Plans, required from 2025.

Please note, signposting to additional support for schools seeking to make strategic investment in building and other infrastructure development is provided but is not a core focus at this time.

Key Benefits

- Cost Reduction: Decrease spending on energy, water, and waste disposal.
- **Students Engagement:** Over 1,000 curriculum-aligned resources inspire pupils to take part in missions that help drive efficiencies.
- Access to Rewards: such as free books, book credit vouchers and book supply discounts (for schools and families) and more when participating in Wastebuster campaigns and services.
- **Environmental Impact:** Lower your school's carbon footprint, measurable improvements and contributions to environmental performance (e.g. energy, waste, water, biodiversity), enhance and demonstrate your sustainability practices and commitment.
- Strategic Support: Access tools and resources designed to align with DfE sustainability and
 Ofsted financial efficiency policy. Access to dedicated schools support for West Sussex
 Council maintained schools, including in person assembly visits.

Quick Start Steps

- Plan your sustainability journey Use the <u>Climate Action Planner</u> to set goals and track your impact. Check the <u>Year Planner</u> for key campaigns and activities.
- Choose your missions/ challenge
 - All Schools: Participate in <u>Wastebuster Campaigns (on the POD)</u>, some are suitable for all schools, while some are targeted at primary.





- Primary schools: Join the <u>Planet Protector Challenge</u> (PPC) complete missions, earn awards, and benchmark progress with other WSCC schools.
- Secondary schools: Access Wastebuster extensive resource library and/or take part in the <u>Climate Enterprise Awards</u> – develop real-world environmental solutions and enterprise skills, with potential funding.
- Assess your starting point Conduct a baseline assessment using Wastebuster's tracking tools to measure impact and savings across energy, water, waste and more.
- Take action Implement waste and energy reduction strategies using curriculum-aligned resources. Engage your school community in Wastebuster campaigns and services to support change and resulting savings and benefits.
- Track progress & celebrate success Use your <u>Wastebuster Account</u> to review performance, adjust plans to optimise cost savings, and share achievements to inspire continued action.

- Report achievements to stakeholders, demonstrating compliance with DfE climate goals and Ofsted efficiency criteria.
- Track your school's environmental savings and achievements using Wastebuster's tools and reports.
